



Sugar Hill Lane Stormwater Rehabilitation Rockdale County, GA

Rockdale County contracted with Site Engineering Inc. (SEI) to coordinate a Storm Drain Rehab project in a residential area on Sugar Hill Lane. Prior to SEI being contracted Rockdale had their filed crews begin this project, which quickly proved to be more than initially anticipated. SEI was brought in to pick up where the county left off. Work performed by the county included an in-complete storm system, resulting in multiple sink holes in the landscape as well as concrete and asphalt damages.

Approximately 300LF of various sized Reinforced Concrete Pipe (RCP), two head walls and three manholes were installed by SEI, as well as a tie-in to an existing drop inlet. In addition to the storm pipe installation SEI coordinated the rehab of the damages incurred to the properties during construction. An extensive landscape remodel of multiple properties along with new driveways, curb, gutter, and asphalt.
